Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL)

Regulation 62

Annual Report 2015/16

In the 2015/16 financial year the Council received a total of £90,542 in respect of CIL from liable developments.

The administration allowance was £4,527.10. This was used to defray CIL administration and set-up costs.

The strategic proportion was £72,433.60. This was transferred to a CIL Strategic Reserve and carried forward, unspent, to 2016/17.

The neighbourhood proportion was £13,581.30. Of this, £9,996.30 related to neighbourhood CIL from developments in the unparished Bath Area. This was transferred to a CIL Local Reserve and carried forward, unspent, to 2016/17.

The remaining £3,585 related to neighbourhood CIL from developments in Radstock, Clutton and Midsomer Norton and was distributed as shown below:

- Radstock Town Council £30
- Clutton Parish Council £1,155
- Midsomer Norton Town Council £2,400

These local councils will report separately on how they have utilised their 2015/16 CIL neighbourhood proportion.
