Policy H2A (Purpose Built Student Accommodation)

Clarification Note

- 1. Policy H2A in the Local Plan Partial Update sets out the Council's approach to provision of Purpose Built Student Accommodation (PBSA) across the District.
- 2. Applications for **PBSA** are assessed using **policy H2A**, and any other relevant policies within the Local Plan.
- 3. Applications for **HMOs** are assessed using **policy H2**, and any other relevant policies within the Local Plan.
- 4. Consideration as to whether an application is for provision of PBSA, and therefore assessed using policy H2A, will be determined using **planning judgement on a case-by-case basis**, considering various criteria relating to, but not limited to:
 - Whether accommodation is a specifically designed accommodation facility for students
 - The scale of the development
 - Provision and type of shared amenities
 - Proposed management of the development, including security, management and cleaning
 - Whether basic facilities and utilities are included within the cost of accommodation
- 5. The supporting text relating to policy H2A in the Local Plan Partial Update sets out a definition of PBSA at paragraph 370a, as follows: *PBSA is accommodation built, or converted, with the specific intention of being occupied by students.*Such accommodation is usually provided in the form of cluster flats with shared facilities, individual en-suite units, or studios, and relates to buildings which are not classified by planning use class, or licensing, as HMOs.
- 6. This definition will continue to inform planning judgement when considering whether an application is for provision of PBSA, apart from the wording relating to buildings being classified as a HMO by licencing.
