

RECEPTION ADMISSIONS - SEPTEMBER 2024

ALLOCATION STATEMENT FOR PENSFORD PRIMARY SCHOOL

PLACES AVAILABLE: 15

As Pensford Primary School was oversubscribed it was necessary to use the Academy Trust's admissions criteria, as published in 'A Primary School for Your Child – 2024/25', to allocate the places available at the school. Applications for all schools are considered under an equal preference system which means that all preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd) for each school are considered equally. If there are any cases where more than one of the school preferences named on the application form could have been met only the highest preference school has been allocated.

A total of **35 preferences** were originally received for Pensford Primary school which has a published Admission Number of **15** for 2024-25.

If, under any of the categories listed, places were offered and refused, priority was given to those who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line between the home address and the school.

How the initial allocation of places was made for this school:

- 1 place has been offered to a child with an Education, Health and Care Plan where the school has been named in their plan. This child is included within the Admission Number for the school.
- **0 Category A Applicants -** Children Looked After Children who are in the care of a Local Authority or have previously been but immediately after being looked after became subject to an adoption, a child arrangement order, or special guardianship order.
- **10 Category B Applicants -** Children who live within a 1.5 mile radius of the school and for whom there will be a sibling who lives at the same address in attendance on the admission date at the preferred school.
- 3 Category C Applicants Children who live within a 1.5 mile radius of the school.
- 1 Category D Applicant Children who live outside a 1.5 mile radius of the school and for whom there will be a sibling who lives at the same address in attendance on the admission date at the preferred school (with priority being given to children living closest to the school as measured in a direct line from the address point of the school). The furthest direct line distance between the preferred school and the home address offered in this category was 2.125 miles.
- **0 Category E Applicants -** For Reception only, children of teaching staff who have been in post for at least 2 years.
- **0 Category F Applicants -** Children who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line from the address point of the school.
- 5 children in total have initially been refused a place at Pensford Primary School. (All other preferences originally considered have qualified for another school as a higher preference)

Please Note: If you decide to lodge a formal appeal for a place at this particular school your initial notification of intent to appeal should be sent to your home local authority by 30 April 2024 by email to admissions_transport@bathnes.gov.uk or for those without this facility to the Postal Address at: Admissions & Transport, People & Communities Department, Lewis House, Manvers Street, Bath, BA1 1JG and your letter of appeal for Pensford Primary School should be sent by no later than 14 May 2024 to either of the same address.
