# INITIAL ALLOCATION STATEMENT FOR ST. JULIAN'S CHURCH SCHOOL

### **PLACES AVAILABLE: 16**

As St. Julian's Church School was oversubscribed it was necessary to use the Academy Trust's admissions criteria, as published in 'A Primary School for Your Child – 2024/25', to allocate the places available at the school. Applications for all schools are considered under an equal preference system which means that all preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd) for each school are considered equally. If there are any cases where more than one of the school preferences named on the application form could have been met only the highest preference school has been allocated.

A total of **32 preferences** were originally received St. Julian's Church School which has a published Admission Number of **16.** 

If, under any of the categories listed, places were offered and refused, priority was given to those who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line between the home address and the school.

How the initial allocation of places was made for this school:

0 place have been offered to a child with an Education, Health and Care Plan where the school has been named in their plan. This child is included within the admission number for the school.

- **0 Category A Applicants** A 'looked after child' or a child who was previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to an adoption, child arrangements, or special guardianship order. (see additional notes)
- **7 Category B Applicants** Children who at the time of application have an older sibling attending St. Julian's Church School and who will still be on roll at the time of admission and who lives at the same home address.
- **0 Category C Applicants** Children who at the time of application are eligible to receive a Pupil Premium or Service Premium Grant.
- **0 Category D Applicants** Children of permanent members of staff.
- 9 Category E Applicants Children who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line. The furthest direct line distance between the preferred school and the home address offered in this category was 2.180 miles.
- **1 child in total has initially been refused a place at St. Julian's Church School.** (All other preferences originally considered have qualified for another school as a higher preference)
