

3SG's annual survey was sent to third sector organisations working across **Bath** and North East Somerset in October 2021. A total 97 organisations responded.

Key Figures

90% of organisations are worried about finding **long-term funding**

84% of organisations are concerned about staff wellbeing

77% of organisations forced to seek new income streams as a result of Covid-19

48% having difficulty recruiting volunteers

77% of organisations want to collaborate more in the year ahead


97% of organisations viewed collaboration as a positive, with the other 3% unsure

core costs






69% of organisations sought new income via grants &
