The Placemaking Plan sets out detailed policies to deliver the Core Strategy, including site allocations and district-wide Development Management policies.
Ecological Emergency	B&NES declared an Ecological Emergency in July 2020, recognising the severity of the degradation of the natural environment and loss of wildlife, the consequences of this, and the urgent need to take action to restore nature.
Green Infrastructure (GI)	Green infrastructure (or blue-green infrastructure) refers to a network that provides the "ingredients" for solving urban and climatic challenges by building with nature
JGIS	West of England Joint Green Infrastructure Strategy
LCA	Landscape Character Assessment: A report commissioned by the High Littleton Neighbourhood Plan group to capture the character of the Parish and provide supporting evidence for the plan.
Local Green Spaces	The designation of land as Local Green Space through local and neighbourhood plans allows communities to identify and protect green areas of particular importance to them.
Local Nature Recovery Strategies (LNRS)	Local Nature Recovery Strategies are a new, England-wide system of spatial strategies that will establish priorities and map proposals for specific actions to drive nature's recovery and provide wider environmental benefits.
