







Change 3 - Independent Travel Training


Independent Travel Training is training for young people to learn how to travel on their own.



Change 4 - Applying for travel support


In our new Travel Support Policy, we have made it easier for families to understand how to apply for travel support.

Change 5 - Explaining words


In our old Travel Support Policy we used some words that people do not understand.



We will check if families still need travel support as the child grows up.


In our new Travel Support Policy, we have:

Change 7 - Behaviour


In our old Travel Support Policy there was no information about how children should behave on school transport.



In our new Travel Support Policy we have included information about how we expect children to behave on school transport.



Change 8 - When we do not give travel support


In our old Travel Support Policy there was no separate section explaining who we do not give travel support to.



In our new Travel Support Policy we have included a new section that explains who we do not give travel support to and why.



Sometimes a family chooses a school which is not the school closest to them.




Usually, we cannot give travel support to these parents and carers.

In our new Travel Support Policy we have included information about:




• Car seats and when a child should be using one.



• Who should buy a car seat for a child if they are using school transport.




