WHAT NEXT?

- 1. Businesses express their interest in the charter by getting in contact with the Charter Team (charter@westofengland-ca.gov.uk). Businesses are invited to attend an optional in person or virtual session to understand more about the Charter, its characteristics and share initial thoughts on areas they would like to focus on.
- 2. Businesses are then asked to complete an action plan to identify one or more charter characteristics they would like to improve their employment practices in.
- Once the action plan is complete, supporters are sent a supporter pack, including a supporter logo and Business Support Guide.
- 4. Businesses join the charter network, attending workshops and events in the areas they have identified as needing improvement. Supporters who are interested in membership can contact the Charter Team.
- 5. On a yearly basis, supporters with the support of the Good Employment Charter Team, review their action plan.
